Equipment	Sets of woods of varying sizes which may be borrowed are in the men's changing rooms. In addition woods can be hired from the council ticket office. Jacks may be borrowed from the bar, a deposit may be required.	See a member of the bowling committee
Green fees	Before playing on any green, a fee must be paid at the council ticket office. Season tickets are also available.	Attendant
Guests of members	Members are welcome to invite guests along. Up to 4 guests may be signed in at any one time. Guests may visit up to 6 times per year.	Club or Bar steward
