- Do not participate in the competitions of any other club;
- Do not take part in any local district league competitions for any other club.

Each competition is played under a referee to whom any queries concerning dates of play etc. must be referred.

Finals must be played on Finals Day. The committee, however, reserve the right to alter this if players are involved in finals of more prestigious competitions such as E.B.A., Sussex County, L&SCBA etc, or if the green is unfit for play.
